




Figure 1: Jennifer Bennet, 18, who will perform as a Snowflake, flower in The Nutcracker, stretches before rehearsals.

Three dancers from the Beijing Dance Academy's ballet program are taking part in Goh Ballet's Nutcracker performance, set to open its sixth season Dec. 18 at The Centre.
